Sociology of religion:

1. What is religion?

<u>Substantive definitions:</u> emphasis on faith in God, spiritual creatures, on the paranormal.

<u>Functional definitions:</u> pay attention to the positive social effects of religion, such as bringing people together and providing purpose.

2. Key classical theorists:

a. Emile Durkheim (1858-1917):

Book: The Elementary Forms of Religious Life

Key concepts: _ Sacred vs. profane; collective conscience. _ Religion creates social solidarity; reinforces norms and values.

- b. Karl Marx (1818_ 1883): religion as ideology; aids ruling class.
- c. Max Weber (1864_ 1920):

Book: The Protestant Ethic and the Spirit of Capitalism.

Beliefs (Calvinism): hard work, discipline, reinvestment.

3. Functions of religion:

- Social Cohesion
- Social control
- > Provides meaning
- > Supports or resists change

4. Contemporary views:

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- **Secularization Thesis:** religion's declining impact in contemporary society.
- **Civil religion:** public ceremonies and religiously inspired patriotic symbols.
- **♣ New Religious Movements:** growth of non-traditional religious communities.
